OUR PURPOSE

The Colorado Society for Respiratory Care (CSRC) grants committee will work in partnership with the CSRC Board of Directors to promote the educational, research and humanitarian aspects of respiratory care in the state of Colorado and abroad.

The Committee manages all operations related to the issuing and distributions of grants from monies obtained by the CSRC and others who wish to donate or sponsor specific grants from time to time.

This Committee also offers general feedback to the CSRC Board of Directors on issues of importance to grant making.

The CSRC Grants Committee shall be restricted to only those activities that are consistent with CSRC's non-profit status.

OBJECTIVES

The Committee shall support the following specific tasks:

- 1. Grant Application Review*
- 2. Awarding of Grants*
- 3. Distribution of grants*
- 4. Grant Allocation*
- 5. Grant Management*

The CSRC Board of Directors may add or remove tasks as deemed appropriate, and any tasks added or removed must also be supported by the Committee.

Review of Grant

The committee shall review, score and discuss all grants applications quarterly based on purpose, method and impact on the community. Then a single grant will be awarded based on a simple majority vote. The committee may call applicants to a meeting to present the details of their application in person.

Awards

Applicants will be notified by mail if awarded specific grants. In the interest of furthering the profession of respiratory care, the awarding of grants will be done in a public venue such as a CSRC sponsored event.

Grant Recipients

After receiving the grant and completing their project, the recipients will have the opportunity to have their work recognized by their peers. Recipients will present their completed project at a CSRC sponsored event to demonstrate how it impacted lives and promoted the field of respiratory care in the state of Colorado or abroad.
